May God bless you and uphold you.

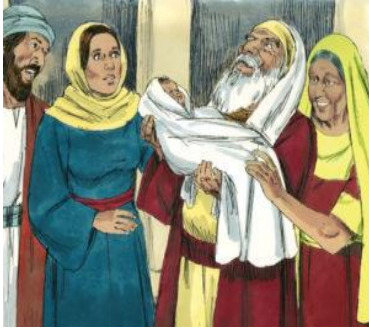


Farewell and Welcome.
